Must bring the following:

- 1. C clamp or small pipe clamp (for clamping your polyester board to the work table)**
- 2. Very small artist paint brush (to apply black lacquer to inside the repair area)**
- 3. Shop apron and safety glasses**

The following are not mandatory but would enable the class to be more efficient :

- 1. Fast RPM buffer with lambs wool buffing pad or drill with a buffing attachment**
- 2. Dremel tool with a high speed steel rounded bit (to prep inside of repair before the polyester fill)**
- 3. Aerosol can or small bottle of black lacquer**
